BOARD AND LODGINGS ON RESIDENTIAL VISITS

MUSICAL ACTIVITIES

• An appropriate charge may be made to a pupil receiving "individual" tuition (groups no larger than 4 pupils for a non-prescribed public examination or for activities which are not related to the National Curriculum.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

- Parents/carers may be invited to make voluntary contributions for resources or materials used in school.
- Parents/carers may be invited to make voluntary contributions for any activities taking place inside or outside school hours (other than residential).
- Pupils will not be excluded from activities if parents/carers have not made voluntary contributions, however the school reserves the right to cancel activities for which insufficient funding to cover costs is received from voluntary contributions.

DAMAGE, BREAKAGES AND REPLACEMENT OF LOST ITEMS

The school will ask parents to pay some or all of the cost of avoidable damage or loss caused by a pupil.

This policy will be monitored and reviewed regularly by the governing body finance and resources sub-committee.
